Passenger travel to country and rural areas continued to be steam hauled until the 1960s. Air-conditioned carriages with comfortable seating and on-board refreshment services (left) were progressively introduced, and journey times reduced with diesel locomotives and self-propelled diesel trains. The XPT introduced the greatest technological change to the railways in the 1980s, and today the XPT (above) and Xplorer trains provide relaxing and comfortable travel between Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne and the outlying country areas of New South Wales.
