



All in a day's work

CityRail transports over 900,000 passengers a day from the suburbs of Sydney to the bustling inner city. While complaints about the trains not running on time are as old as the hills, commuting to work is looking up with the Rail Clearways Plan launched by Premier Bob Carr in April 2004 (and due to be completed in 2010) with new carriages to be rolled out in 2005 for outer suburban areas and the Hunter. Another 498 air-conditioned carriages will be built for introduction onto the CityRail network before 2010.
