### **CityRail resumes services to Blue Mountains for PM peak**

CityRail has announced the resumption of out-bound train services on the Blue Mountains Line with the 3:52 PM service from Sydney to Lithgow in the direction of the PM peak.

Train services had been suspended following a train derailment at Woodford yesterday afternoon and a number of landslips affecting the line.

RailCorp Chief Operating Officer Andy Byford acknowledged the patience of customers affected by the suspension of services.

“While landslips caused by heavy rain are beyond our control, RailCorp does acknowledge that customers are inconvenienced and we thank them for their patience and understanding during such incidents,” Mr Byford said.

“RailCorp rail engineers worked at the affected sites throughout the night to restore services as quickly as possible and this has enabled us to resume services in time for and the direction of this evening’s peak.”

Customers travelling on city-bound services will still make use of buses between Katoomba and Springwood.
