### **Rubbish left at Eskbank**

I'm writing to you to clarify the unacceptable situation which saw rubbish left at Eskbank over the week.

The material left was waste generated by platform resurfacing works and a general cleanup at Lithgow Station, which was being carried out by a group contracted to RailCorp.

Unfortunately the contractor did not finish removing the waste material after the job was completed as instructed. This was unacceptable.

The contractor in question has been reprimanded and was ordered to remove all rubbish at the site by yesterday afternoon.

On behalf of RailCorp, I apologise to the members of the Eskbank Rail Heritage Centre and the Lithgow community for the rubbish that was left at the site.

It is disappointing for both RailCorp and the Lithgow community that this regrettable incident occurred, and we assure everyone that has an interest in the Station that all efforts will be made to ensure this does not happen again.

I look forward to RailCorp continuing to work with the Eskbank Rail Heritage Centre and the Lithgow community towards improving the historic Eskbank Station so that it can be a source of local pride for many years to come.
