### **Free breakfast for CityRail customers at Wollongong and Thirroul**

CityRail is thanking customers for their patience last week during disruptions caused when a Pacific National coal freight train derailed near Coalcliff, Acting General Manager, Customer Service, Pat Duffield said today.

Train services were suspended between Waterfall and Thirroul for four days while recovery and repair crews worked around the clock to restore services.

“We understand many of our customers experienced delays and disruptions to their journeys while the recovery took place and were inconvenienced as a result,” said Mr Duffield.
