### **Thursday's Industrial Action Deferred**

RailCorp today said the combined rail unions have agreed to defer Thursday's planned industrial action on the CityRail network.

"RailCorp and the unions negotiated from mid-morning yesterday until well into this morning," said RailCorp CE Rob Mason.

"The unions have agreed to take a number of offers to members on Wednesday.

"As a gesture of goodwill, the unions have also decided to defer Thursday's planned four hour stoppage.

"It's a very welcome gesture and means commuters will be able to get to and from work on Thursday.

"This is a good indication that significant progress has been in reaching an agreement.

"There's still some way to go and we're committed to working with the unions to reach a fair resolution.

"Further discussions between the two parties will be undertaken later in the week."
