Blow off some steam at Sydney Great Train Weekend

Experience the grandeur and excitement of the steam train with the whole family during Sydney's Great Train Weekend at Central Station over the June long weekend Saturday 12 to Monday 14 June 2010.

Famous steam locos 3642 and 3526 will be loaded up to provide a great-value family adventure travelling in 1930s-era carriages, with 75-minute return trips through the suburbs from Central Station to Clyde on offer.

You will also be able to explore some of our more recent railway history by inspecting the famous **Southern Aurora**[®] glamour express train of the 1960s. Marvel at the craftsmanship and style of a bygone era - see elegant, antique sleeping and executive carriages.

"Whilst you're at Central, take a look at some of our proud railway history, with a display of classic heritage trains for you to explore," RailCorp CEO Rob Mason said.

"Also at Central we have the Great Railway Journey's of Australia exhibition, which recently went on display, and provides a snapshot of our continent's most exciting railway journeys.

"We have a rich heritage fleet and we are proud to share it with the public during weekends such as the Great Train Weekend at Central Station.
